#### The perfect world is the perfect number of perfectlyskilled people working perfectly together.

Surprisingly, most of our veteran volunteers stopped volunteering when we expanded into our own clinic. The social atmosphere and workload completely changed. - Too few volunteers, resulting in excessive workload
- Too many volunteers, resulting in insufficient work for all
- Poor training and feelings of inadequacy
- Not understanding the physical stamina needed
